



I'm not sure how long I'll be writing bulletin entries, but it seems fitting for now. I was privileged to share in some of Fr. Krizner's creativity, and his beautiful thoughts over the course of our friendship and working for him. If I can be a bridge between him and you in any way during this time of transition, it's my honor, truly. So I'm happy to share some thoughts with you. As I think back to the events of the last three weeks— Fr.'s passing, Holy Week, Easter, Fr.'s Mass of Resurrection, newfound (grateful) guidance under Fr. Bob Stec, and the very first week of a 'new' (unwanted) normal without my Fr... I can't help but be in awe of how much these events parallel the Easter Season. Today's Gospel is the Road to Emmaus... Fr. LOVED this Gospel. The picture on the front of the bulletin today belongs to him. I remember the many times he preached about it.... It's Easter Sunday night, and two disciples of Jesus recall the

past days, feeling a sense of hopelessness as everything they knew with the friend they loved was gone. Don't we feel that way? Haven't the past 16 years under Fr.'s beautiful leadership been the most fun and spiritually uplifting? Doesn't it in a way feel a bit hopeless as we've "lost" such a beloved person to each of us, so quickly, without warning, without a real chance to say goodbye? Sounds awfully familiar to today's Gospel. But



then, the "stranger" comes and walks with them, reminds them of what they've been taught and what they know to be true... that death hasn't won, but been redeemed. It wasn't until the 'breaking of the bread' when the disciples finally realized it was Jesus they were walking with all along. Fr. Andrew Hoover on Holy Thursday said that when we come together at Mass and 'break bread' in the Eucharist, we're not only united with each other present, but with the entire Communion of Saints in heaven, those named by the Church and those members of our families gone before us. This Gospel today not only reminds me of Fr.'s strong belief in the reality of the Eucharist, in the reality of Christ's Resurrection, but in the reality that every time I go to Mass... that WE go to Mass, Fr. Krizner is there with us and all of the saints, with Jesus, and Mary in the Breaking of the Bread. I miss you, Fr. Krizner. We all miss you. And that's not going to go away. But rest assured I'll look for you at Mass, and I hope you all will join me. See you in the Eucharist. ~*Sara*
