


Ace is Risen, just like Ace said!

e's not here. That phrase from the Gospel takes on a whole new meaning for us this past week. Coming to church or visiting the rectory, I feel more of a connection with those women going to anoint the body of Jesus that early Easter morning. Or of Peter and John when they saw the stone rolled away and the shroud strewn on the ground... that empty, hollow feeling of their beloved being gone from the last place they remembered him. He's not here. I understand your broken hearts at the passing of Fr. Krizner. It was sudden for all of us and certainly not what we had planned or wanted. God's plan is bigger- we know this. We've been told this so many times... Just like the apostles were told so many times, "I will die, but on the third day I will rise." What joy, and what assurance must have filled their soul after they remembered what was promised... "I will rise... all who live and believe in me will never die, but have eternal life." For us who remain, we hold onto that promise... that we will see Jesus, Fr. Krizner, and all of our loved ones again because of Easter! Because hope is stronger than fear, faith stronger than doubt, love stronger than death. Fr. Krizner loved being a priest. He loved being your priest and your pastor. Wherever he was sent, St. Columbkille, Holy Name, St. Colette, he made it his life to spread the Gospel message and live his witness of joy, humility, tenderness, hospitality, generosity, faith... such a strong, devoted faith. He can never be replaced, but he can live on through you. As a friend once told me, "We live for those who aren't here" so we can return to each other one day. Be the generous heart of Fr. Krizner. Be the welcoming smile of Fr. Krizner. Be humble in all that you do, and like him, let all you do be for the glory of God. Rejoice on this Easter morning!!! Because this day was made by the Lord, and was made for YOU.


Many of you have asked for the passage I read from Santucci's *Meeting Jesus*. Nothing is more befitting a message from Fr. Krizner. I hope it continues to bring you comfort and peace.

When the clouds have hidden me from your eyes, you'll go on gazing at their restlessly shifting shapes against the silk of heaven. You'd like to stay there for thousands of years, because you were told he'll come back exactly as you saw him rise. Then two men dressed in white will tell you to go home. Obey them, go down with the others. And when you've shut your door behind you, and stand among your poor possessions, and then lean our of your window, know that I have still another thing to tell you. Don't look up at the sky. On this, the day of the Ascension I'm hiding behind a could, but I could equally hide myself behind a bush, in the hollow trunk of a tree, or in a pool in Galilee. The Father to whom I'm going doesn't live beyond the flight of birds. He's on the moors swept by the wind, in unknown haystacks where you may happen to sleep one night, on mountain ridges, under the bed, and on the roofs of cities.

After I've ascended, he and I will be wherever you are in the world.

Then nothing will be strange to you. Whenever you set foot in a strange land you'll recognize it behind some hidden memory because I shall have lived there for you. Whenever you leave a country you'll know that you're not altogether abandoning it, be cause you'll leave me there. Everywhere will be come your motherland and your home. Distances will be wiped out from the moment when I left the hilltop and set out on my travels through the world. Then you'll understand it for this reason: that you'll no longer feel afraid.

My life doesn't end here; if it ended you too would die. It goes on even when you wish for dissolution, because it's precisely in me that you long to be dis solved. Every despair, every travail of your day is a desire to reunite yourselves to with me, to see me again on the clouds, to serve me at table (221-222).




