



ou are Peter, and upon **this rock** I WILL BUILD MY CHURCH...
Leadership matters. It sets and defines the tone from everything from family dynamics to major companies, to national governance. No well-run entity survives without solid leadership. As leadership changes, evolves, or dissipates so do the entities themselves. Family names perish, businesses thrive and plumet, nations rise and fall. Throughout history there's been only one structure that's survived, stood the test of time, seen empires, trends, and the like... and that's the Catholic Church... because leadership matters, and its leader is God himself.

Founded on the back of Judaism (technically the oldest monotheistic faith) as Jesus was a Jew, Jesus made it clear that he was the fullness of God's revelation to man. That everything that transpired leading up to his incarnation was in preparation for him, and that everything to come refers back to him. The Church loves to use metaphors and symbolism to point to truth and reality. So, let's do that. Scripture refers to Jesus as the "cornerstone rejected by the builders." The cornerstone is the most fundamental stone of a building—It's not the first stone, as the foundation is laid first. But from it, the rest of the particulars of the building are calculated. **Jesus is the source of structure and support for the Church, the stone that gives the foundation its significance and the rest of the blueprints its fruition.** Without Him, there's no building... but what about the rest of it? What about the rest of the structure and how does it continue after the "cornerstone" has done his job?

In today's Gospel, Jesus asks his Apostles "WHO DO YOU SAY THAT I AM?" He asks his friends if they "get it"... only Peter responds with "the Christ". Leadership matters... and Jesus knew that like any structure that was to survive it would need solid leadership, a solid rock placed on his cornerstone of truth. Peter proved himself to be that rock. From what we know from Scripture and any theatrical biblical interpretation, Peter is far from the shiniest, smoothest of rocks. He's strong-willed, prideful, self-pitying, and painfully cowardly in difficult situations. And I doubt these flaws ever went away the moment he was commissioned by the Spirit to spread the church. Jesus knew Peter's shortcomings, **but only defined him by his goodness**—his strength and bravery, motivation and work ethic, and passion for truth and justice. Jesus knew the kind of leadership he needed for HIS church--and he's very clear about that... "You are Peter, and upon this rock, I will build MY church." It's Christ's church, and he knew exactly what he was doing when he made Peter it's first pope, then Linus after him, and Cletus after him, and Clement after him, all the way to Francis today. It's CHRIST'S CHURCH, not Peter's, nor Clement's, nor Francis'. Leadership matters.... And Jesus knows what he's doing.

But what about bad leadership within the church, the chaos and turmoil that's existed or still exists... bad popes... anti-popes?!! Hey, we've all read some form of church history. And it's not all pretty. Or what about today's church? It's not all pretty. I'm sure many of us or people that we know have some notion about what the leadership of the church is and is not. So, what do we do... what do we think? We refer BACK to our cornerstone! Here's some Scriptural references to assist with that: Isaiah 55:8-9 God's thoughts are higher than ours; Matthew 7:13-14 Enter through the Narrow Gate; Matthew 7:15-23 Beware of wolves in sheep's clothing; Matthew 13:24-30 The weeds and the wheat; Matthew 14:25-31 Walking on Water; Luke 12:48 To whom much is given, much is expected. AND the

assuring words of Jesus today... "that the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it."

What God creates is good. Therefore, the Church is good. Its leadership is good... and it matters. And if human nature makes a mess of that, God's going to fix it in his time. It's true that God called Peter to be his first rock... but it's also true that we're all called by God to something! If God can still call Peter all the same despite his shortcomings, what beautiful assurance that he calls us too despite our own... That he defines us by our goodness and uses us as building blocks to continue the work of his church, his kingdom that will never pass away. Build your week on that one! And pray for the leadership of the church. Leadership matters. God bless you. Christ's Church! ~Sara




