

Good Morning! Good Afternoon!

..."Brothers and sisters: The Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes with inexpressible groanings. And the one who searches hearts knows what is the intention of the Spirit, because he intercedes for the holy ones according to God's will." The second reading this weekend, from the letter to the Romans, can be summed up like this, "God provides." Even in our limitations, the Spirit of God intercedes and knows our every need. As long as we stay the path of the Lord – live His will and do His work – the Spirit of God will intercede and God will always provide.

Take some time to pray for your grandparents and if they are still with you, ask them to share some stories of faith and family – stories of God's faithfulness.

I vividly remember my own grandfather tending to his garden and taking care of the 'vines' (the grapes). I can imagine being with him in his backyard.
