Hello, Parish Family!

..."The LORD was pleased that Solomon made this request. So God said to him: "Because you have asked for this— not for a long life for yourself, nor for riches, nor for the life of your enemies, but for understanding so that you may know what is right— I do as you requested. I give you a heart so wise and understanding that there has never been anyone like you up to now, and after you there will come no one to equal you." Our first reading from the I Book of Kings is profound. Solomon could have asked for anything and he asked for understanding – so that he may know what is good and right. Can you imagine if that was at the heart of our daily prayer?? **Every day, we should turn to God and sincerely ask for understanding – to know what is good and right.** That prayer, God will always hear and honor.

We will continue the collection through next weekend. It's a simple way to extend the care and compassion of Christ to our young children as they prepare for the upcoming school year.

The response has been very positive as this will make it most convenient for all who attend daily Mass. Finally, coming in a few weeks, you will see some **'freshness' to the Bulletin.** Noah and Sara have been coming up with some ways to 'freshen things up' as we walk into the Fall season.
