# Hello Parish Family!

...”Having come down in a cloud, the LORD stood with Moses there and proclaimed his name, "LORD." Thus the LORD passed before him and cried out, "The LORD, the LORD, a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity." Moses at once bowed down to the ground in worship.” The first reading on this Feast of the Holy Trinity is from the Book of Exodus. The reading is profound in that we receive God’s name (Lord) and learn about the qualities of the Lord. The Lord is merciful, gracious, slow to anger, rich in kindness and fidelity. What a blessing that our God – our Lord – is so kind and merciful to us. Let’s be honest, all of us depend on these qualities of God. And on this Feast of the Holy Trinity, when we celebrate our being a trinity of persons (Father, Son and Spirit), we are going to be best in building the unity of persons if we are kind, merciful and gracious to others.

...The Trinity sets the model of the Church – many persons united and bound together in the love of God. The Church is always best when we follow the pattern given to us by the Trinity.

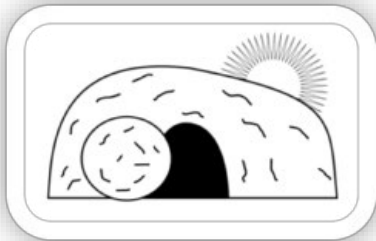

My move here was forced by 2 separate surgeries & rehabs, sandwiched around the CoVid pandemic. Father was ever so encouraging, administering Anointing of the Sick, advising me about retirement. We immediately bonded over his "girls", the bearded collies: THE Lily, Grace and Ann.

I enjoyed his sermons, but even more so our talks together. He was incredibly complimentary of my cartoon drawings, even though they lacked any sophisticated artistry. I would sometimes preview them in conversations, knowing I had a good one if he smiled or outright laughed. His dog pictures with captions, and most especially his short stories in the bulletins, were wonderfully creative. He had a gift for connecting with people; humility, humor, a genuine compassion and his commitment to Christ.

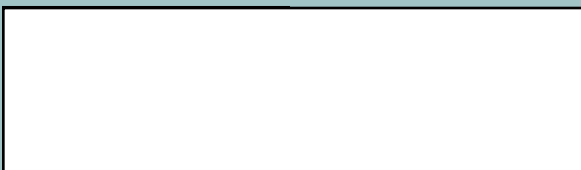

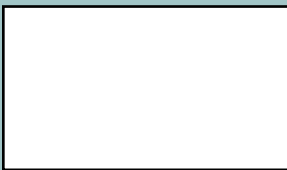
