# Hello Parish Family!

..."Having come down in a cloud, the LORD stood with Moses there and proclaimed his name, "LORD." Thus the LORD passed before him and cried out, "The LORD, the LORD, a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity." Moses at once bowed down to the ground in worship." The first reading on this Feast of the Holy Trinity is from the Book of Exodus. The reading is profound in that we receive God's name (Lord) and learn about the qualities of the Lord. Let's be honest, all of us depend on these qualities of God.
