ASCENSION SUNDAY!

...”Then Jesus approached and said to them, “All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. Fr. Krizner gave me such a profound appreciation for the amazing Feast of the Ascension, and it started when I was a kid in college. He handed me his Santucci and asked me to read the last three paragraphs of the book out loud (as he often had me do with various things, especially his writings— I loved that). He’d reference the book from time to time in a homily, but I never thought of it again until the week he died... then the very day he died it was the very first thought when wondering just how I’d share the news with all of you. And I think it’s the lesson of our lives... Christ gave us “The Great Commission” to “GO” and continue his work. Staying in grief or misery when we lose a loved one doesn’t bring them back or bring their lives any honor... or get us anywhere. Easier said than done. Lisa and I have often discussed during this time that our hardest days after losing Fr. would (and have) come long after his Mass of Resurrection. I’ve found myself “looking at the sky” a lot lately... God’s amazing though... because every time I find myself doing it, I feel a tug on my heart from my dear friend, my dear priest. I hear his voice in my head and feel him in my soul... and like Jesus, I know he’s with me wherever I go. I hope these words from Santucci will once again inspire you!

*When the clouds have hidden me from your eyes, you’ll go on gazing at their restlessly shifting shapes against the silk of heaven. You’d like to stay there for thousands of years, because you were told he’ll come back exactly as you saw him rise. Then two men dressed in white will tell you to go home. Obey them, go down with the others. And when you’ve shut your door behind you, and stand among your poor possessions, and then lean out of your window, know that I have still another thing to tell you. **Don’t look up at the sky.** On this, the day of the Ascension I’m hiding behind a cloud, but I could equally hide myself behind a bush, in the hollow trunk of a tree, or in a pool in Galilee. The Father to whom I’m going doesn’t live beyond the flight of birds. He’s on the moors swept by the wind, in unknown haystacks where you may happen to sleep one night, on mountain ridges, under the bed, and on the roofs of cities.*

After I’ve ascended, he and I will be wherever you are in the world. Then nothing will be strange to you. Whenever you set foot in a strange land you’ll recognize it behind some hidden memory because I shall have lived there for you. Whenever you leave a country you’ll know that you’re not altogether abandoning it, because you’ll leave me there. Everywhere will become your motherland and your home. Distances will be wiped out from the moment when I left the hilltop and set out on my travels through the world. Then you’ll understand it for this reason: that you’ll no longer feel afraid.

My life doesn’t end here; if it ended you too would die. It goes on even when you wish for dissolution, because it’s precisely in me that you long to be dissolved. Every despair, every travail of your day is a desire to reunite yourselves to with me, to see me again on the clouds, to serve me at table (221-222).

What Fr. Krizner meant to me.

It got to the point where I went to the confessional and confessed my feelings and asked Father for advice. He told me to pray the Memorarae at the back of our missalette. This was on a Saturday afternoon.

On Sunday, I went to the 10:00 mass and during the announcement of "intentions" Father announced that the mass was also being said for His "special intention"! Now I have NO idea if His special intention was at all related to Mine, but in my mind, it was! It just seemed too "coincidental". Whether there was any connection at all or not, I have no idea, but I do know that he cared for and took care of all of us! You were a truly Good man and you are severely missed! Incidentally, the "family situation" has improved! R.I.P.!

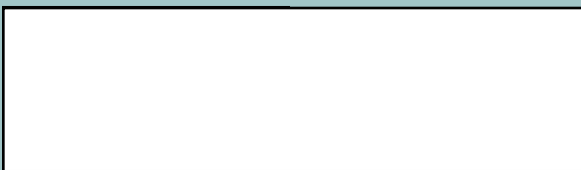

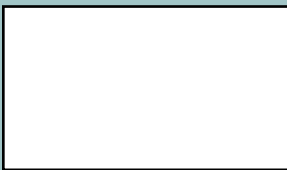
