

Happy Birthday to Us, the CHURCH!

..."On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." The Gospel on the Feast of Pentecost finds those early disciples still locked in their fear and confusion over the loss of Jesus. What did Jesus do? He entered into their worries, fears and concerns and stood in their midst. What did He offer them? The gift of peace. What does Jesus want to do for each of us? In our moments of sadness, loss, worry and fear, He comes to stand with us to bring us the gift of His peace. He gives them the assurance that He is in Heaven and His Spirit – the Holy Spirit – is with us always. His presence should bring us comfort and peace.

...This weekend we bring to a close the Easter Season and celebrate the birthday of the Church – Pentecost. As a community of faith, we can relate to this Scripture passage. It was just about sixty days ago when Father Krizner was called home to the Lord. For those early followers, and for us today, the Gospel should give us the comfort and assurance that Father Krizner is with the Lord and God is with us. This Good News should bring us comfort and peace. Peace be with you is the offer of the Lord. Peace.






