It's hard not to wear my feelings on my sleeve sometimes, and my beautiful little boys can always tell when "mommy's sad." "I miss Uncle," I'll say, when they ask. And Vinny, who's only three, will respond, "that's ok, mommy. Uncle's in heaven with Jesus. He's happy, and has hair and lots of toys. And one day I'll be in heaven with Uncle too." Jesus ends the Gospel by saying, "...whoever believes in me will do the works that I do, and will do greater ones than these..." And God bless these greatest through whom the Lord does his works... the children. Let's live our week the like children do! ~Sara

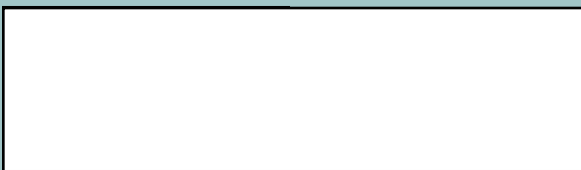

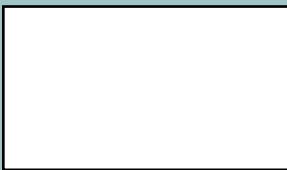
