The 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time

September was certainly a month of tremendous feast days: St. Teresa of Calcutta, St. Matthew, St. Padre Pio, The Archangels: Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, Our Lady of Sorrows... and the streak continues in October beginning today (October 1st) with the Feast of St. Therese of Lisieux, the Little Flower, Doctor of the Church— wow, that's a long title after her name. She must have been a visionary, or a missionary, a miracle-worker, or a great teacher, especially to be named a "Doctor of the Church". Therese was none of those things. She was just a girl who loved Jesus with every fiber of her being, and even as a cloistered Carmelite nun, was able to share that love of Jesus with the world.

What's the definition of the word "love". Ask any number of folks and I suspect, the answer will differ slightly, yet revolve around the truth that love means willing the good of the other for the other's good. Perhaps some might even say that "God is Love"... and they'd be correct. Look at the cross— there's no way God did that for himself, but rather as our second reading from Philippians says today, he emptied himself, he humbled himself, becoming obedient even to death on a cross. And that's the ultimate demonstration of love: that our worldly desires are nailed to the cross for the sake of someone else. Today's Gospel is all about that notion too. In his parable, Jesus tells us about the two sons tasked of doing the work of the Father, the good of the Father. One says he will, yet does not. The other refuses, yet does the work anyway— he demonstrates his love through actions. Jesus says that actions out of love merit the Kingdom— and for us, that means in whatever the circumstances of our daily lives.

St. Therese understood this notion very well. In fact, that's why she's a saint today. Therese always wanted to do great things. She had such a desire to please God, to be a saint! She also knew her limitations and often felt discouraged by them. She believed, however, with all her heart that God would not put a desire within her that he could not also fulfill through her. So if it was a saint she wanted to be, it was a saint she was going to become. Fascinated with the modern technology in her day—elevators—she thought that if man could make a machine to climb floors, then she would create her own "elevator to heaven". What would be known as "her way of love" revolved around the circumstances and people in her daily life. She approached each one by "nailing her own desires to the cross of Christ" and offering every action as a prayer on someone else's behalf. Her kindness even had a cruel, difficult sister in the convent thinking they were the best of friends. Therese became ill with Tuberculosis at the age of 24. Her last months of life we lived in excruciating pain, suffering and even the temptation and fear that it was all for nothing, that maybe God did not exist (saints were real people).

Through all of it, she held onto the love of Christ, emptying herself, humbling herself, and like Christ remained obedient until death...and with a promise. Therese's way of self-giving and love became so a part of her that she vowed to even live her heaven in giving to others: "I will send down a shower of roses from the heavens. I will spend my heaven doing good on earth." It wasn't enough for Therese to understand the unbounded love of Jesus, she wanted the world to know it then and to know it forever. Perhaps you've prayed to St. Therese and have received one of these roses, I know I have. And all I can say is, how good is our God! And how good is he that he doesn't specify tremendous actions in order to receive the kingdom but only actions done out of love. So the next time you feel small or insignificant, remember the love of Christ crucified for you!... Remember the witness of St. Therese, that even the smallest of flowers can become the greatest of saints! St. Therese, pray for us! ~Sara
